WP1: Analysis of the frameworks on well-being and sustainability at national and international level for policy making

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Work Package 1

Need: official statistics need coherent frameworks on wellbeing and sustainability delivering consistent evidences and narratives to policymakers.

Main aim of WP1: compilation of a comprehensive collection of the existing initiatives and frameworks on well-being as well as the available SDG indicators at local, national and European level referring to official statistical production.

The work in WP1 will help to reorient the definition of wellbeing and sustainable development frameworks to enhance a more direct use by policy makers and the use of evidencebased decision making practices.

Work Package 1

Focus on building on the achievements of previous European projects and on national experiences on well-being and SDGs to help providing a common framework.

In a second step the integration between different experiences will concentrate on the analysis of micro-macro approach. The potential of the extension of national accounts to the household level developing micro-macro approaches represents a crucial elements in the inclusion of beyond GDP indicators within the SNA framework.


Task T1.1

National experiences – the Netherlands

- Statistics Netherlands recently started publishing reports on SDGs indicators in the Netherlands
- Proposal is to do an analysis on:
 - Which SDGs are relevant for the Netherlands
 - Which indicators are computed
 - Which data sources are available (traditional and non-traditional)
 - Which sources are / what is missing to produce remaining SDGs indicators
 - Which potential indicators are missing in the current frameworks
- Results: input for WP2



National experiences - Germany



Among national experiences Germany is working on exploring the use of satellite data to identify SDG indicators that have not been explored yet, according to the results obtained by different working groups.

The United Nations Global Geospatial Information Management (UN-GGIM) will publish a task report in the beginning of 2018, on four SDG indicators which could be determined by remote sensing data.

On this subject it would be useful to explore the work of the Working Group on Geospatial Information (WGGI), as well as the intergovernmental Group on Earth Observation (GEO).

National experiences - Hungary

Examples of national experiences in formalized inclusion of well-being indicators in the policy process

Italy: with the new Italian budget law, national policies will be evaluated also in terms of well-being, through the monitoring of a set of well-being indicators.

France: Parliament is required to publish an annual report to monitor the impact of legislation on well-being of the population.

Description of work: Task 1.2

Task T1.2

Beyond GDP frameworks usually encompass subjects which only partially overlap with the System of National Accounts. Yet the evaluation of the potential for SNA to include beyond GDP measures is a key element for their institutionalization and actual use. The task recalls the state of the art of the subject and elaborate proposals for extending the System on the basis of a micro-macro approach derived inside the national account framework.

Description of work: Task 1.2

The common picture has to take into account the huge literature that, within the national accounts (NAs) system has provided theoretical and empirical evidences to compile measures of the distribution of household income, consumption and savings within the framework of national account.

Investigations have started in improving the collection of data at household level and in combining micro data from surveys and administrative data sources with national accounts aggregates.
